MSDS or also known as Material Safety Data Sheet training is likewise included in the course. Although not directly related to the use of a lift truck, MSDS training is vital if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on individuals and right methods of dealing with spills.
