Introduction

Warehouse operations which are efficient and orderly tend to be more successful and safer. It is essential for the worker to transport and store the goods throughout the facility in an efficient and timely manner. Due to the multiple activities involved within warehouse operations, employees in warehouse settings might be at greater risk for accidents compared to individuals who work in areas with more limited activities. Therefore, companies place a top priority on warehouse safety.

Knowledge of possible warehouse dangers is important to preventing accidents. Always be alert to possible dangers and methods to reduce risks. Do whatever is required to prevent accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse environment are trips, falls and slips. These accidents are normally caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over a thing that has not been put away properly. Removing or placing objects from storage could cause a slip or fumble, potentially causing both employee and thing to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when employees are moving things on different types of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common danger is getting hit by falling stuff. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting methods are one more common hazard.

Warehouse equipment carries inherent dangers. Injuries or accidents could be caused by conveyors, hand trucks and forklift trucks if they are not operated correctly. Warehouse tools, like skids, pallets, strapping and cutting tools, should be used carefully throughout unpacking, packing and loading.

Dangerous substances, flammable or combustible materials could pose danger while being stored inside a warehouse. Workers must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards while working around hazardous materials.
